## ***From the President (Mike Schulz)***

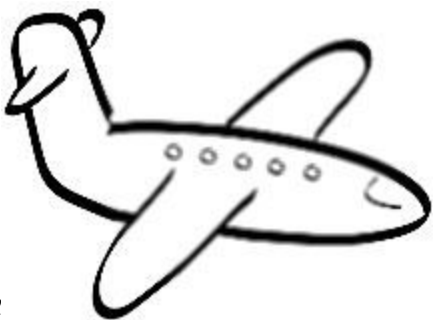
